High School Scholarships 2022-23 & 2023-24

The Lanna International School Executive Board and Senior Executive Team are delighted to invite students to apply for Lanna High School Scholarships for the academic years 2022/23 and 2023/24. **Applications are being accepted from now through to 8th April 2022**

Rationale:

- Incentive for top performing existing students to continue into our A Level Programme
- To attract new top performing students into our High School Programmes

The Scholarships:

1. **LANNA Sixth Form Scholarships, for current students entering our Sixth Form Programme** (moving into Y12/13)
2. **LANNA High School Scholarship for top performing students from other schools** joining our High School Programmes (joining Y10 to 13)

1. LANNA Sixth Form Scholarships, for current students:

LANNA's **Sixth Form Scholarships** are intended to recognise LANNA students that demonstrate exceptional academic performance, and dedication to the school and its ethos. These scholarships provide assistance with tuition fees, of between 40% and 80%, and are available only to current LANNA students transitioning from Y11 into Y12. Scholarships that are awarded continue through into Y13, subject to review during semester 2 of Year 12.

To apply, students must meet the following criteria:

- Current Y11 LANNA student
- Currently predicted to obtain top grades in a wide range of IGCSE subjects.
- Student displays strong character and commitment to community and school life
 - *e.g. involvement and leadership in extra-curricular activities (sports, arts, LIPSO, Student Council, MUN, LQ, etc.); mentoring new students; peer tutoring; community service*
- Parents are committed to the school and their child's ongoing education at LANNA
 - *e.g. involvement and/or leadership in the PTO; assisting with extra-curricular activities*
- The student has special talents or qualities that will add value to life at LANNA

2. LANNA High School Scholarship for top performing students

LANNA's **High School Scholarships for top performing students** are available to non-LANNA students that are able to demonstrate exceptional academic performance, and are applying to join LANNA High School (Y10, 11, 12 or 13). Scholarship amounts of between 40% and 80% of school tuition fees may be awarded.

To apply, students must meet the following criteria:

- Non-LANNA student applying to join LANNA High School (Y10, 11, 12 or 13)
- Able to demonstrate and evidence a very high level of academic performance
- Student displays strong character and commitment to community and school life
- Parents are committed to joining LANNA school and their child's ongoing education at LANNA
- The student has special talents or qualities that will add value to life at LANNA

The Board has the final decision to the awarding of the scholarships and to the amount of tuition fee reduction to be awarded. All cases are considered on their merits and include interviews with both the student and parents.

All applications require:

1. **A hand-written personal statement** of up to 600 words, written by the student for whom the application is being made. This must include why they feel that they should receive a scholarship, and what they believe they will bring to our school and/or the wider community (please attach this as a scan/photograph of the hand-written statement)
2. The student’s **academic reports** for the last two years along with any other supporting documentation that indicate high level academic performance and/or their special talents or qualities that will add value to life at LANNA
3. **Character references** (up to 3 allowable)

Part 4 – Interview Process

Short listed applicants will be invited for interview:

Students and parents will be required to attend an interview with the Scholarship panel, either in person, or via zoom if unable to attend personally. The scholarship panel is made up from Head of School, Secondary Principal and Head of Sixth Form.

The interview is an opportunity for the student and at times parent, to answer questions from the panel, as well as ask the panel members questions about LANNA. Shortlisted applicants will be given more details at time of invitation.
