

Fee Schedule 2019 – 2020

Enrolment Fees:

Application & Pre-admission Assessment (Paid at the time of testing)

4,500 THB

This is a fee for application testing (for students entering year 1 and above) and assessing the potential students for suitability to enter the school, as well as ensuring the school is able to meet the needs of the child.

Registration Fee

55,000 THB

This one-time fee is to cover the costs incurred when registering as a new student

Book Deposit

13,000 THB

This covers the cost of any books which maybe lost or damaged during the course of the students attendance at the school. This will be refunded upon the student leaving the school, less any costs that are required to be recovered.

The above fees are payable one time only for new students.

Students who leave the school and return more than 12 months after leaving will re-incur the above fees.

The above fees (with the exception of the book deposit) are strictly non-refundable.

* The tuition fees include all examination fees including IGCSE (approximate value 16,180 baht – 20,800 baht for 7-9 subjects), A/AS Levels (approximate value 17,400 baht for 4 AS and 3 A2 subjects).

NB: The tuition fees include the cost of Year 6 Tests (approximate value – 1,800 baht) and the cost of Primary Check Point (approximate value – 91,900 baht) for years 1-6 are also included

Additional Fees:

Mandatory Fees (These are fees which have to be paid each year by all students and are strictly non-refundable):

Annual Capital Fee

10,000 THB

This helps to pay for new construction and developments at both the Primary Campus and the Early Years/Secondary Campus, which either helps to improve or maintain the facilities at both campuses. These fees may also pay for replacing capital items that have served their useful life or have become archaic.

PTO Contribution (per student)

650 THB

This goes to the Parent, Teachers Organisation and is managed by this organisation to both provide a link between the school and the parents and also enable highly valued work and contributions to the school.

Accident Insurance Supplement - Mandatory

950 THB

Whilst the school makes every effort to maintain the safety for all students. This helps to contribute towards the cost incurred associated with any accidents whilst attending the school.

Optional Fees (These are fees incurred for services provided by the school, but the parent of the student can choose to receive them or not receive them):

Additional Notes:

Fee reductions for families with 3 or more children

1. A 25% reduction in tuition fees is available upon enrolment to families of three or more children. This will be available to the youngest child only. The reduction is limited to one child per family.
2. The pre-admission assessment fee is waived for the third child only.

Important Notes

1. For existing students, a re-enrolment deposit of 30,000 THB is payable each school year to secure the student's placement for the following school year. **This non-refundable deposit** is deducted from the fees payable for the new school year. The due date for 2019-20 re-enrolment fee is March 8, 2019. Payment after this date will not guarantee the students' placement.
2. For new students, all enrolment fees must be paid within 10 days to guarantee a placement at the school for the 2019/20 academic year.
3. All tuition fees must be paid and received by the financial officer by:
 - Semester 1 – Friday 9th August 2019
 - Semester 2 – Friday 27th December 2019
4. For students joining during the academic year the tuition fee for the relevant semester must be paid at least 5 working days before they start. If the student starts school within 5 days of enrolment, tuition fees must be paid the day prior to commencing.
5. All payments received after the dates specified in notes 3 and 4 above will automatically incur a 10% late payment fee of the outstanding amount.
6. Payment plans will be considered, but requires approval by the Associate Business Manager at least 5 days prior to the start of the students first day of school and will incur a 5% one-time surcharge.
7. Refunds of tuition fee only can only be claimed on the basis specified below. No other refunds will be given:
 - 70% of the tuition fees will be refundable if a student withdraws prior to the beginning of the school semester.
 - 50% of the tuition fees will be refundable if a student withdraws between 1-20 days subsequent to the commencement of the school semester.
 - 20% of the tuition fees will be refundable if a student withdraws between 21-40 days subsequent to the commencement of the school semester.
 - No refund will be given if a student withdraws after 40 days or more days subsequent to the commencement of the school semester.
