

Lanna International Summer School Overview

Lanna International Summer School's goal is to provide a safe place where children can work, learn, and grow, while maintaining a safe, caring and creative environment. It will provide an appropriate balance of academic and creative hands-on activities through which children can develop, socially and academically during a summer of fun active learning.

Lessons & Activities


The majority of the learning will be based upon the topic of the Olympics and will involve using the following skills:

Water Fun!

Primary School children (Aged 5-8) will enjoy water fun in our paddling pool and splash area on a daily basis. As such, each child needs to bring their swimming costumes, towels and sandals each day. All swimming items will need to be taken home each day to ensure they are clean for children to use.

Children (aged 9-14) will also enjoy water fun in our swimming pool and splash area. As such, each child needs to bring their swimming costumes, towels and sandals on the scheduled swimming days. All swimming items will need to be taken home after use.



General information

Staff

Summer School staff will consist of experienced qualified experienced teachers and Teacher Assistants.

Attendance

School starts at 08:30 and finishes at 14:00. If arriving late, leaving early or absent, please make sure to call the office in advance. The office will be open from 08:00 and will remain open until 15:00 each day.


Children may start to arrive from 08:00 at which time a duty teacher will be at the main school gate. All classes will be met in the playground by their teachers and then taken inside.

Children will be released in the cafeteria at 14:00. All children need to be collected by a specified adult. A form will be given at a later date for parents to indicate this information.

Please inform the teacher in the morning if you have made arrangements for your child to be picked up by someone else at the end of the day. The school must be cleared by 14:30 each day as the school site will close.

Snack Time / Lunch Time

Children are expected to bring their own snack. However, lunch is provided at school each day. Please pack a healthy mid-morning snack and a drink. It is essential that children have plenty of water to drink, so a personal refillable bottle is needed.



What to Wear

Children should wear casual, light summer clothes and light shoes. No additional indoor shoes are needed. Please label all items of clothing.

At the Primary site, every Monday, please make sure your child brings a swimsuit, towel and appropriate wet footwear (Crocs, flip flops, water shoes). Goggles are optional. These will be returned each night for washing.

At the Secondary site, on scheduled swim days, please make sure your child brings a swimsuit, towel and appropriate wet footwear (Crocs, flip flops, water shoes). Goggles are optional.

Lost and Found Items

Please make sure personal belongings are named. At the end of Summer School, we will display any lost and found items. Please understand that any leftover items not claimed will be disposed of.


Parking

At the Primary site, please use the car park to park your vehicle when picking up your child. You will need to pick up your child from the cafeteria and sign them out with your class teacher. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

Fees

All fees must be paid prior to attending the Summer School. These can be paid in cash to the school office or via a bank transfer. Further details can be found on the application form. The fees are structured as follows:

Total Cost- 30,000 BHT including all tuition, lesson resources, activities, field trips, snacks/lunch for non Lanna students and **25,000 BHT** for Lanna students.

Policy


In line with our normal school policy, please be aware that parents are not allowed to take pictures of the children on school premises.

Also, children are not allowed to bring smart watches to summer school. If they do these will be collected at the start of the day by their teacher and given back at the end of the day.

Terms and conditions

I. Summer school tuition:

- We ask that you make any cancellations as soon as possible to aid a smooth transition and running of the Summer School programme. Please note that there are no refunds at all of any Summer School fees.

II. Cancellation of school:

- No refund for any summer-school-related fees in the case of cancellation of school due to extreme events beyond the control of school and its staff.

III. Rights of the school:

- Lanna International Summer School reserves the right to reject the application —even after the start of summer school— of any student who is unable to function at an appropriate level in the English language, and/or whose behaviour is consistently inappropriate. After a written warning to the family, any student who is asked to leave the summer school programme based on circumstances covered in the aforementioned will receive a full tuition refund for any week(s) he/she is enrolled in that follow the week in which he/she is asked to leave. There will be no tuition refund for the week in which he/she is asked to leave.
